

**STATUS OF ESTABLISHMENT OF AREA LICENSING
BOARDS UNDER 'ENGULI' ACT AND MODALITIES FOR
THE REGULATION OF THE MANUFACTURE OF
JAGGERY**

A. ESTABLISHMENT OF AREA LICENSING BOARDS

THE ENGULI (MANUFACTURE AND LICENSING) ACT, CAP 86 of 1966 is an Act to regulate the manufacture, licensing and sale of '*Enguli*' and for other purposes connected therewith. The Act prohibits the manufacture and sale of '*Enguli*' without licence. Under section 4, the Act provides for establishment of Areas Licensing Boards to determine the total number of '*Enguli*' Licences that may be issued in Uganda in any one year and limit the number of such licences that may be issued in any District. With the developments in the Alcohol Industry and investment licensing regime in the Country, this law is now obsolete, no longer applicable and was recommended for repeal. In 2013, Cabinet approved the implementation of Business Licensing reforms and authorized the First Parliamentary Counsel to repeal a number of licenses and permits that included '*Enguli*'
