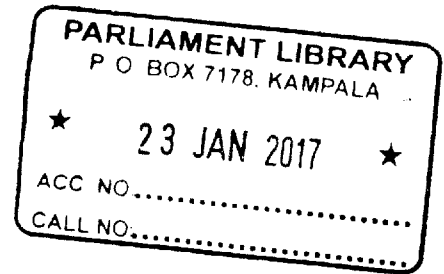

**THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2017.**

**An Act to amend the Local Governments Act, Cap. 243 to reduce the time for the display of the voters' roll in respect of elections at administrative units; to provide for the Electoral Commission to determine objections arising from the display of the voters' roll in accordance with section 168B of the Act; to reduce the time provided for campaigns and for related matters.**

BE IT ENACTED by Parliament as follows:

**1. Amendment of Cap. 243.**

The Local Governments Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act is amended by substituting for section 159A, the following—

**“159A. Display of voters' roll for administrative unit elections.**

For the purposes of the village, parish and ward elections, the following provisions shall have effect notwithstanding the Electoral Commission Act—

**Act**                      *Local Governments (Amendment) Act*                      **2017**

- (a) the period of display of the voters' roll under section 25(1) of the Electoral Commission Act, shall be at least two days;
- (b) objections to the voters' roll shall be decided by the Electoral Commission in accordance with section 168B."

**2. Amendment of section 161 of the principal Act.**

Section 161 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (4) by substituting for the words "seven days", the words "one day".
