PETITION TO THE PARLIAMENT OF UGANDA.

(Under Rule 30 of the Rules of Procedure of the Parliament of the Republic of Uganda)

The **HUMBLE PETITION** of residents of Kagarama Town Council, Ntungamo District; presented by Hon. Timuzigu Michael Kamugisha, Member of Parliament for Kajara County.

SHOWETH AND STATES THAT:-

1. The subject matter of the petition regards the compensation of the residents of Kagarama Town Council who are the persons affected by the Ntungamo-Kagamba Road Construction Project (2001 to 2005);
2. Your humble petitioners aver that-
 - (a) prior to the construction of the Ntungamo-Kagamba road, Government carried out an evaluation of the properties belonging to the residents of Kagarama Town Council, Ntungamo District who would be directly affected by the road works;
 - (b) despite the fact that the evaluation of the properties was carried out, no compensation has been made to the residents affected by the construction of the said road to date;
 - (c) on 4th September, 2002, the Director, Road Agency Formation Unit wrote to the Chairman LC V and Chief Administrative Officer, Ntungamo District reassuring the owners of land or properties who had and would be directly affected by the road works that their cases would be reviewed once the Ntungamo-Kagamba road was constructed, however this reassurance has never come to fruition ;
3. Your humble petitioners have further sought the intervention of the Resident District Commissioner, Ntungamo District, Chairman LC V Ntungamo District, the Chief Administration Officer, Ntungamo District, Road Agency Foundation Unit and the Ministry of Works and Transport to no avail;

4. Your humble petitioners contend that the current situation in Kagarama Town Council, Ntungamo District requires urgent intervention because the affected residents of Kagarama Town Council, Ntungamo District, having lost their properties to the road works, are disgruntled and still see no hope of compensation;

NOW THEREFORE your humble petitioners pray that Parliament intervenes and carries out an investigation into the compulsory acquisition of their land by the Road Agency Formation Unit for purposes of constructing the Ntungamo-Kagamba road without compensating them.

AND your humble petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray;

We the affected residents of the Kagarama Town council Ntungamo District forward our petition in respect of the un compensated properties during the construction of Ntungamo Kagamba road construction in 2001 – 2005.

According to the evaluation by the government valuer done by Bageine and Company Advocates in reference to the affected properties in 2001, in Kagarama town council Ntungamo district. Evaluation was done but no compensation effected to date.

This is in evidence of the letter dated 4th September, 2002 addressed to the Chairman LC V Ntungamo District and The Chief Administration officer Ntungamo District.

The same letter assurance for compensation had also been made but has never been done. Since then complainants have been going and negative feedback received.

The letter from Uganda National Authority dated 23rd November, 2017 is attached in reference to our un-compensated claim.

In reference to the document AB 12/288/01 in the meeting between Ntungamo District stakeholders and the government committee on assurances and implementation (GAIC) the same complaint was presented.

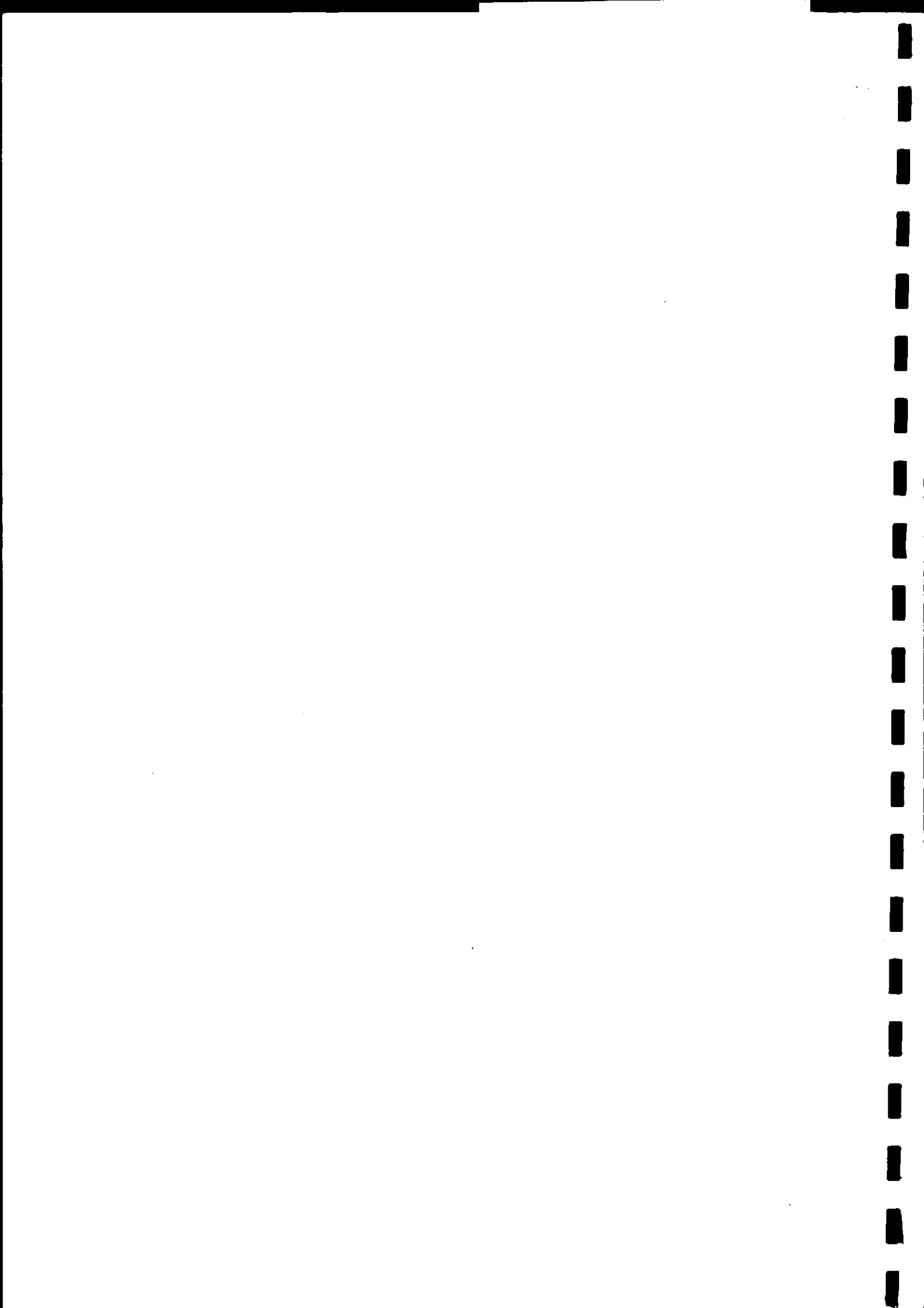
We have noted that Uganda National Road Authority (UNRA) has started using our land yet we have never been compensated hence the fear for our houses and properties.

Land and Properties Compensation

As you are aware, M/s Energo Project, the Contractor, has been paying out compensation, on behalf of Government, to persons affected by the Ntungamo - Kagamba Road Construction Project.

There have, however, been some interruptions in the compensation process at Kagamba Trading Centre and a meeting was held on 30th August 2002 to address the people's complaints. It was agreed at this meeting that RAFU clarifies in writing a number of issues and gives assurance that all affected individuals will be compensated. Please find our explanation as follows:

1. The Compensation Report

The survey and compensation report describes all the properties which are the subject of compensation as a result of the construction of the Ntungamo-Kagamba road. These are properties situated within the designated road reserves i.e within a 20 metre road reserve for sections of the road within trading centers and 30 metres road reserve outside the trading centers. The properties include land, houses, trees and crops.

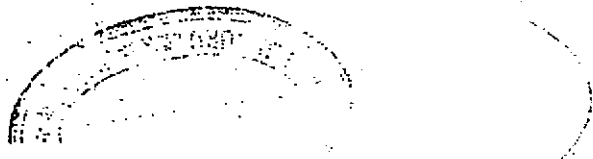
2. Basis of Valuation

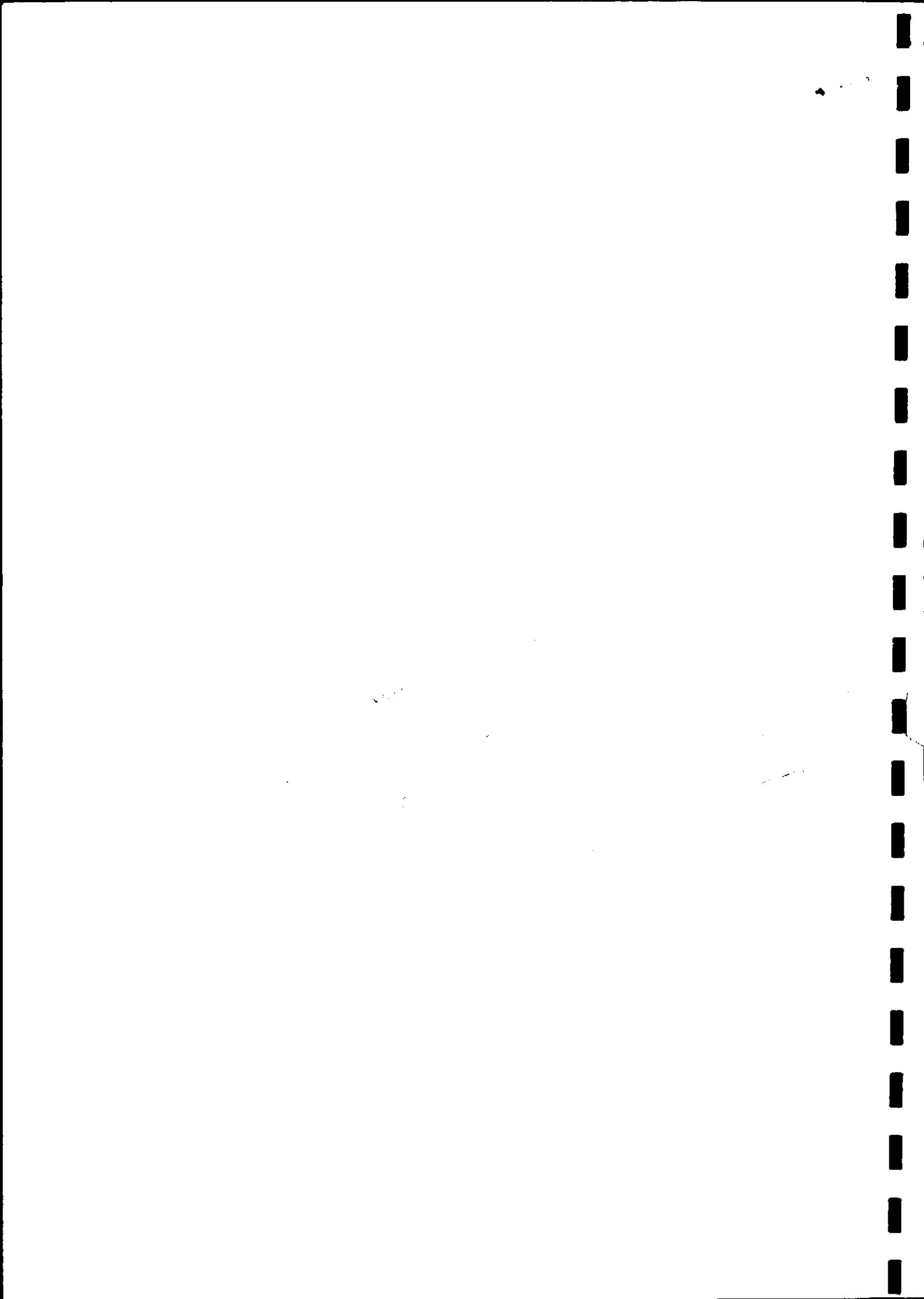
The basis of valuation for land is the open market value while that of semi-permanent houses, trees and crops were based on approved compensation rates for Ntungamo District for the year 2001. The valuation of permanent houses is not covered by the District Compensation list but was based on open market considerations. All the rates have been approved by the Chief Government Valuer.

3. Disturbance Allowance

A 30% disturbance allowance was added to cater for lack of a six months' notice to all assessments of the properties to be compensated.




4. Compensation amounts

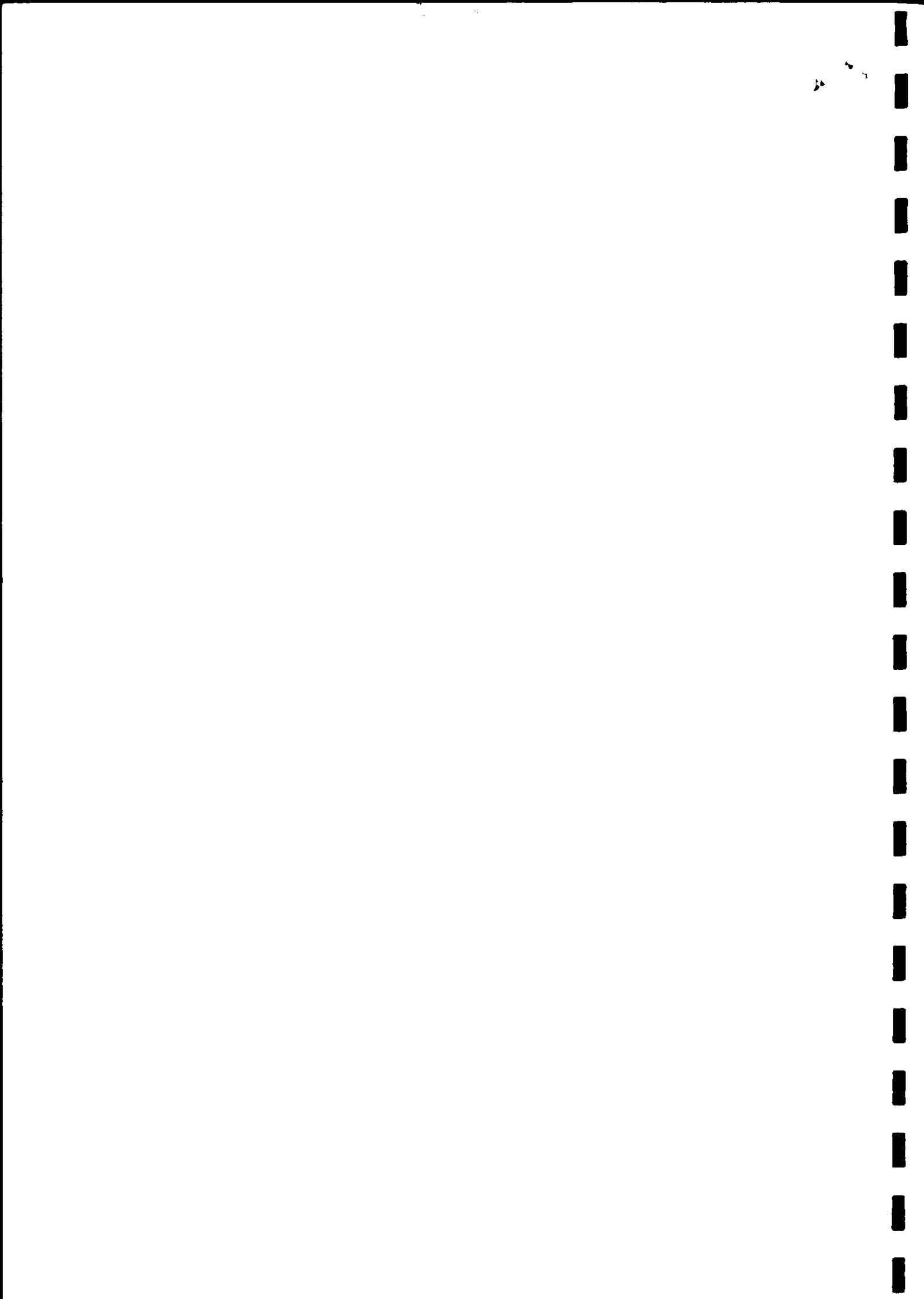
In some cases the compensation values returned for properties were very small. This was due to the very small pieces of land acquired, even though such land was located in trading centers where land values were higher.

We would like to reassure those owners of land or properties which have or will be directly affected by the road works, that their cases will be reviewed once the Ntungamo-Kagamba road section has been constructed. This will give Government time to consolidate all individual cases into one valuation roll for approval. For any damage to property caused by the Contractor during the course of construction, people should report to the Resident Engineer who will take up the matter with the Contractor on their behalf. In both situations we shall ensure that payments are made as soon as possible.

It is further stated that following the said assessment by the Valuers, a valuation report was compiled, however to date, no compensation has been made to your clients, hence your demand from Uganda National Roads Authority (UNRA) to effect compensation payment to your clients.

Please note that the rights and liabilities of the former Road Agency Formation Unit were not assigned to the Authority (UNRA) when the Authority was established in 2006. Consequently, in the absence of legal mandate, the Authority cannot effect compensation payment to your clients.

We advise that you address your request to the Ministry of Works and Transport.

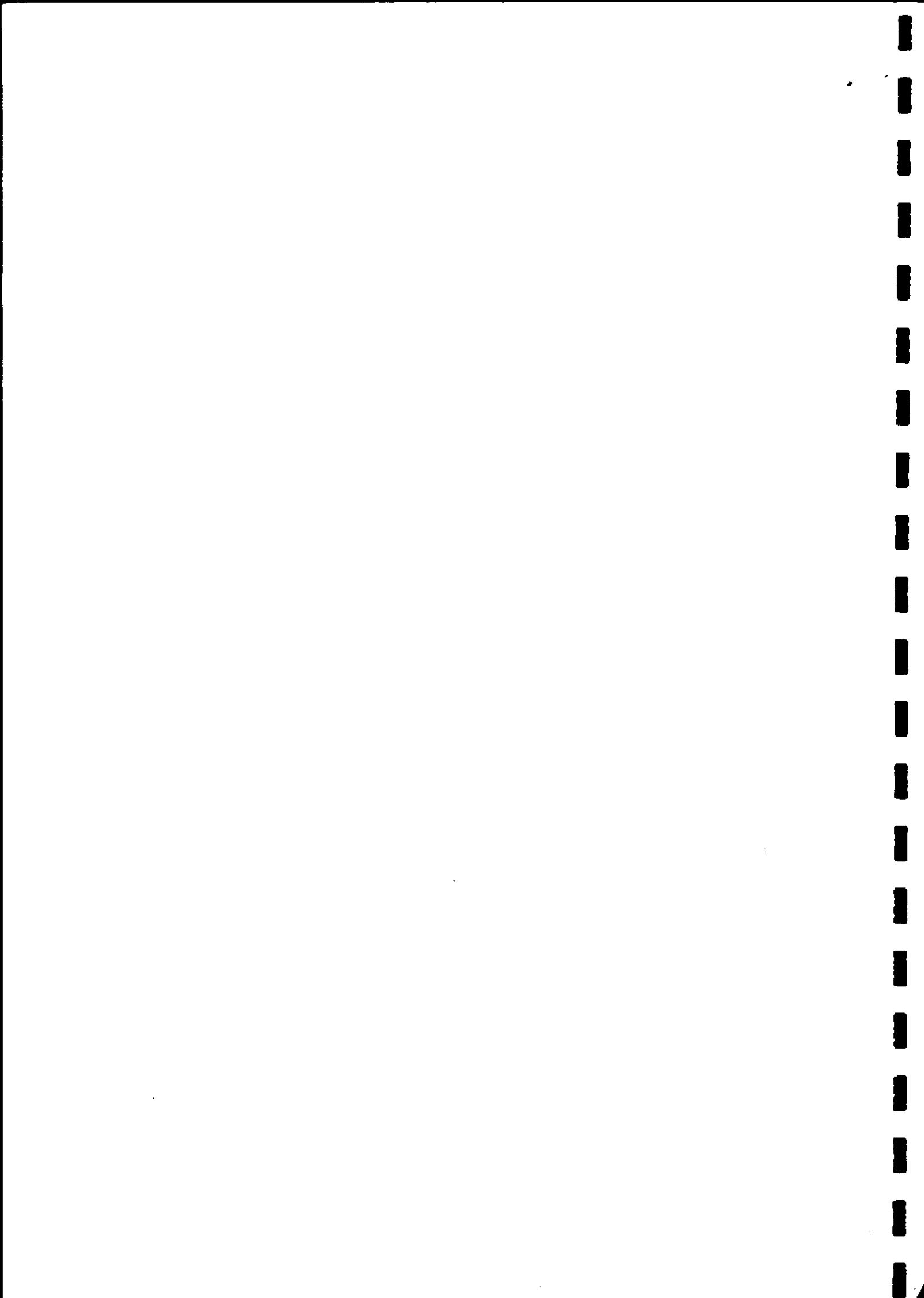
