ENTITLED

THE STAMPS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2010

An Act to amend the Schedule to the Stamps Act, prescribing rates of stamp duty.

BE IT ENACTED by Parliament as follows:

1. Commencement.

This Act shall come into force on 1st July, 2010.

2. Amendment of Schedule to the Stamps Act Cap 342.

The Schedule to the Stamps Act is amended—

(a) by substituting for item 8 the following—

“8 (a). Appraisalment or valuation made otherwise than under an order of court - of the total value	0.5%
